MLOA Summer Meeting Minutes

Treasurer was not able to attend. No specific financial updates.

Review of phase 2 roadwork/financials

Jenny Rosenbahl has from paid general funds (phase 1 \$) to cover phase 2 roadwork.

- 1) Estimate was provided; no contract for the work. There was not enough to pay for the road. Two \$500.00 assessments. Some phase 2 people paid up to \$1000.00. Some paid nothing.
- 2) Bottom Line: Keith Roland was not going to be paid for the work he did and was charging the association interest. There was a possible \$8000.00 payment due. The association agreed to pay Keith with general fund money.
- 3) Discussed that no future work should be done without a written contract. The person who makes the deal is liable.
- 4) Lien must start a lien because the association is getting steamrolled because people haven't paid.

II. Liens Discussion

Volunteer time is needed.

- 1) How much does it cost?
- 2) How can the association encourage people to pay dues?
- 3) Must get a lawyer to negotiate the fees.
- 4) \$1000.00 and no effort to correspond to pay e.g. reason to place lien.
- 5) Recommendation to get multiple sets of liens with approximate cost of under \$50.00.

Nancy Cook: Do you feel like people got their money for the road? Yes everyone feels they got their money for the road. Greywacke (SP) insisted on specification of general dues.

- 6) Association tries to accommodate people.
 - a. Per rate lien.

- b. Write letter re: when lien starts.
- c. Consider charging interest on liens.
- d. Look for pro-bono Attorney work. Suggestions were Mike McCarthy, Alaska Attorney.
- e. People to champion this effort. Jenny Rosenbalm, Jeremy will look into lawyers.
- f. Bob Cook will help get a packet e.g. lawyer costs (hourly rates).
- g. Larry Cohen was also recommended, Jeremy will speak to him.
- h. Jeremy will look into if there is already existing paperwork.

Motion: \$2000.00 authorized to spend for Liens

- 1) Support Jeremy and Bob in their effort to find lien formats.
- 2) Oct 15, is the date lien after which liens can be assessed.
- 3) To avoid a lien members must make a contract with a schedule for payment.
- 4) Anyone owing over \$1000 without a payment plan contract is subject to a lien.
- 5) The contract must include a 20% per year minimum payment on the original debt.
- 6) Liens can include a 5% fee as well as a prorated fee for all costs associated with the lien.
- 7) There can be a hardship exemption (with approval from a board majority).

Motion: Passed

Motion: Lien amendment

- 1)Letter informing members of the lien is to be delivered by 1/15/2015. President offered to make it happen.
- 2) Board able to authorize liens without further neighborhood vote if it can be done for a cost of up to \$2000 to the subdivision.

Motion: Passed

New Business Item.

- 1) State fund [Revenue Sharing].
- 2) Legitimate home owners association in the university land.
- 3) State dollars for road maintenance may be available.
- 4) Start thinking about a Community Well.
- 5) Look for public funds (Tamara may be able to do leg work).

Motion:

1) To get revenue sharing funds. Tamara knows the system.

- 2) Publicly dedicated road \$2800.00 to redo the road.
- 3) Bob will talk to Tamara and Mary Montgomery for lien formats

Fire – Burning update (all NPS burning is now complete, below details state forestry burning)

- 1) Nazina road to subdivision removing dead downed trees. This will happen partially this year.
- 2) Chris Chester is the contact for the fire burning.
- 3) They will Clear every thing that is a fire hazard up,to,10 ft from road
- 4) Agreement is to clear 10ft to 8ft to the ditch boardering the road.
- 5) Nazina road to end of the subdivision is state funded. Probably will not finish to the river this year.
- 6) Going forward with previous plans to clear brush.
